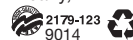

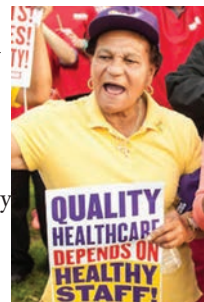


Ann Perry
