## HELP CLINIC WORKERS SLAM DUNK A NEW CONTRACT

It's no secret that Columbia University has plenty of money. In 2015, Columbia's President Lee C. Bollinger brought home a total compensation of nearly \$2.5 million (\$2,473,682), and some other executives each made close to a million that year.

Yet, the university is dragging its feet on contract negotiations with the eight healthcare workers at the student medical center. They refused to let us join other 1199SEIU workers who already have a contract at Columbia, and we therefore have inferior health insurance to our fellow union workers. The university also didn't give us new uniforms for over two years. They finally gave us new uniforms on the same day that we refused to wear our old ones. This seems quite petty to us!

Columbia is also refusing to let us form a Health & Safety Committee to address health and safety issues for workers. The health and wellness of healthcare workers inherently affects students and the entire community that we treat.

Tell Columbia president Lee Bollinger to bargain a fair contract with healthcare workers!
