Two years later, just weeks ago, there was another catastrophe at Emerald South, which resulted in the death of another resident.

A CALL TO ACTION

It's time to protect the most frail and vulnerable Western New Yorkers. For-profit nursing home operators, who are often absentee owners expanding their downstate based money-making businesses to upstate regions, are making millions of dollars on the backs of nursing home residents, their families and caregivers. Meanwhile, many of the facilities, including Emerald South, are poorly staffed. They also don't supply the resources that we need to provide quality care.

We're doing our best to provide quality care under these challenging circumstances. But it's time for the nursing home owners, management teams and state regulators at the Department of Health to take responsibility and repair the situation.

The more we shine the light on the business practices of the owners who put profits before quality care, the sooner they can be held accountable for their actions, and the situation can be remedied. In the meantime, we must continue to keep on the pressure and make our voices heard.
